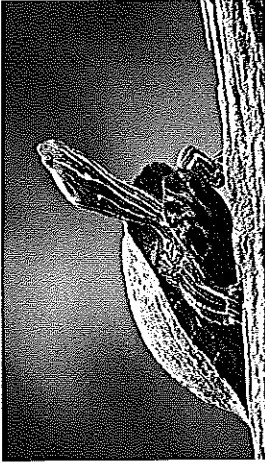

TRAC SUMMER CAMPS

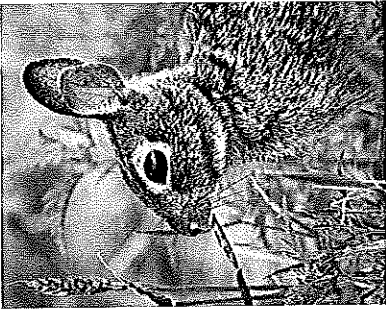
Time to Register!

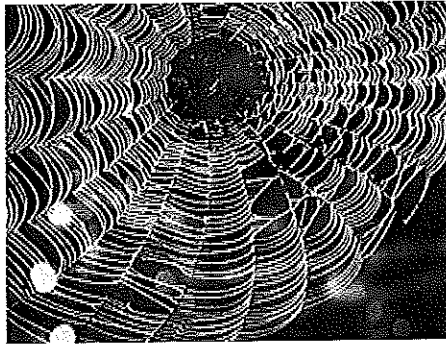

ENDANGERED GRASSLAND

Double the fun: Dallas Zoo/TRAC
Entering 4th and 5th grades
Session 1: Jul 12 - 16

"Endangered Grasslands" at the Dallas Zoo and the Trinity River Audubon Center. This new camp takes children from the world of the African savanna to our own Blackland Prairie, the most endangered ecosystem in the United States. Spend Monday through Wednesday at the Dallas Zoo, and then spend a fun-filled, action packed Thursday through Friday (including a staff-supervised overnight) at Trinity River Audubon Center. \$234 for members of the Dallas Zoo or the Trinity River Audubon Center (\$260 for non-members).
